Reuben D. Kroeker grew up in Newton, Kansas and was inducted into the U.S. Army on July 14, 1941 in Sacramento, California. He completed basic training at Camp Grant, Illinois and served in the Army Medical Corps at Camp Grant and Camp Ellis, Illinois. He received a Good Conduct Medal SO# 57 which was presented June 14, 1943. Pvt. Kroeker was a patriotic citizen and loved his country. Reuben was discharged at Camp Ellis on July 14, 1943 and lived the remainder of his life in Peoria, Illinois.

In 1943, he married Wanda Snyder of Knox County, Illinois. They had four children, one is deceased. Reuben died on January 14, 2004 in Peoria. His family has submitted the story of his WW II service to honor him and to keep his memory safe.
