Neal R. Roy grew up in Fond du Lac, Wisconsin and joined the U. S. Navy during World War II. He was trained and served as a Hospital Corpsman. He was sent to the Pacific Theater of War and served in a field hospital on the island of Guam. Following the war, Neal remained in service working with veterans with post traumatic stress at St. Louis, Missouri. There he met his future wife who was a Navy Wave, Bertha P. Kunzik of Springfield, Illinois.

After discharge, Neal and Bertha were married and made their home in Springfield. They had a son David and a daughter Suzanne. Neal R. Roy died on April 30, 1973 and is buried at Camp Butler National Cemetery near Springfield, Illinois.
