George H. Taylor joined the United States Air Force at the age of 30 during World War II. He was sent to Scott Field, Belleville, Illinois and to Camp Beale, California. George was trained in radio mechanics and then taught radio mechanics to men that were training to be gunners and radio operators on the rear end of the B-17 bombers.

At Camp Beale, California, George also helped at the Separation Center for men and women that were being discharged from service. He received the Sharp Shooter Medal and several others. George Taylor served in the Air Force for 3 years.
