James N. Clark joined the U.S. Marine Corps in June of 1942 and was sent to boot camp at San Diego, California. He finished parachute school in 1943 and was shipped overseas on April 1, 1943. James was in the battles on New Caledonia, Guadalcanal, Vila La Vila, Choisel and Iwo Jima. He was wounded March 10, 1945 and received the Purple Heart.

James remained in the Marines after World War II and was sent to Korea from October 1950 to November 1951. He retired from the Seabee Reserves in 1984 with 24 years of service. James and his wife Pat live in Phoenix, Arizona and Mexico. He served a total of 11 years and retired with the rank of master Sergeant.
